RESIDENTIAL SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT PROGRAM CITY OF MENDOTA

- 1.) Only residential properties are eligible for concrete reimbursement; owner-occupied properties will be given priority consideration.
- 2.) To enroll in the program, notify the Street Superintendent, Nick Stremlau, at 400 11th St. (538-4786). Eligible properties are listed on a "first ready, first serve" basis. The City for this program has appropriated an annual amount of \$15,000.
- 3.) The Superintendent of Streets shall inspect all such properties on the Sidewalk Replacement list to determine the need and extent of the work that the property owner wishes to accomplish; if, in the Superintendent's judgement, the sidewalk is in adequate repair at the time of the initial inspection, he may determine that the applicant is ineligible for City reimbursement of concrete costs.
- 4.) Assuming the sidewalk is in need of repair, as approved and authorized by the Street Superintendent, the City will pay the cost of a minimum of one cubic yard for corner and multi-lot parcels (PROPERTY OWNER MUST PAY SERVICE CHARGE IF CONCRETE REQUIRES A MINIMUM CUBIC YARD ORDER, OR IF THERE IS ANY ADDITIONAL CHARGE FOR "AFTER HOURS" SERVICE -e.g., Saturdays, etc.).
- 5.) The following sidewalk specifications must be met:
 - a) Sidewalk is poured to a 4" depth; 6" when traversing a driveway.
 - b) The existing width of the sidewalk must be met.
 - c) Score or Score-cut every 4-5 feet at a depth of 1/4 the thickness of the concrete.
 - d) PROPERTY OWNER INCURS ALL LABOR COSTS, IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER EXPENSES TO REMOVE, FORM, POUR AND FINISH THE CONCRETE.
- 6.) Concrete will be ordered by the Street Superintendent.

FAILURE TO OBTAIN THE PRIOR APPROVAL OF THE STREET SUPERINTENDENT BEFORE PROCEEDING WITH YOUR SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT MAY RESULT IN NOT GETTING YOUR CONCRETE PAID BY THE CITY.
